In this workshop, participants will gain a working knowledge and awareness of different statuses within Virginia fence laws. Items covered include but are not limited to the origins of fence law in Virginia, the difference between common law and general law in terms of fence structures, definitions of a lawful fence, and many other important items of not pertaining to Virginia fence laws.

Virginia Fence Law is more complicated than the terms “fence in” or “fence out”. It is subject to a wide range of state regulations covering foreseeable scenarios and situations between landowners and farmers as well as subject to various county ordinances. Farm operators and landowners will benefit from the information presented in this workshop to assist them in risk aversion decision making regarding future and current fence construction and maintenance.

Jennifer Friedel, J.D., Virginia Tech, will be on hand to discuss fence law, county differences, and various case studies regarding fence disputes.
